This is in response to your May 12, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, a copy of which is attached for your convenience. We received your request on May 13, 2010 and assigned it case number 10-F-1000 for tracking purposes.

The Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics, and the Office of General Counsel (OGC) conducted a search for the records you requested. OGC advised that the Office of the Secretary of Defense does not control or maintain the database or types of ethics opinions requested in Part 1 of your request; the U.S. Army does for the entire department. Your appeal must be postmarked within 60 calendar days of the date of this response. Your appeal should cite case number 10-F-1000, and be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal".
